Licenciada en Farmacia, Especialista en Análisis Clínicos (vía FIR), Doctora en Salud Pública y Máster en Epidemiología (Imperial College of London). Contrato Río Hortega.

Además de la calidad de la difusión de la investigación (más de 100 artículos científicos, la mayoría pertenecen a revistas del primer cuartil), desde el año 2005 he sido investigadora principal en 12 proyectos de investigación: 7 de convocatoria pública nacional (Fondo de Investigaciones Sanitarias, ISCIII). Asimismo, he participado como investigadora principal en 4 contratos de investigación. Como investigadora colaboradora he colaborado en 5 proyectos de investigación: 1 de la Comisión Europea, 2 de convocatoria pública nacional y 2 de convocatoria pública autonómica. Desde enero del año 2018 soy la Jefa del grupo 26 del CIBER de Salud Pública y Epidemiología. Desde el año 2014 me incorporé como miembro al equipo internacional del STARD Group (Essential Items for Reporting Diagnostic Accuracy Studies). He sido nombrada como una de las investigadoras más citadas del 2022 según Elsevier (entre el 2 % de los más citados del mundo).

En los últimos cinco años he dirigido 6 tesis doctorales, todas ellas con la máxima calificación Sobresaliente Cum Laude, habiendo recibido dos de ellas el Premio Extraordinario de Doctorado y la Mención Europea. Asimismo, he dirigido 18 trabajos fin de máster y 16 trabajos fin de grado.
